Emergency Cards for School trip

Managing the financial actions of any school, trust or academy can be tricky, especially when it comes to trips in the UK and abroad – we get it. And it only gets worse when you have a trip coming up at short notice.

Previously, St Edmunds Catholic school, part of the St Francis & St Clare Catholic MAC, managed school trips by giving cash to staff to use for lunches, items to buy for the classroom and general expenses. 


